# PPCB slaps ₹5-cr fine on Ropar thermal plant, withdraws 'consent to operate'

The Punjab Pollution Control Board (PPCB) has imposed a fine of Rs 5 crore on the Ropar thermal plant for violating environmental laws. In an order passed on July 7 after a hearing before the PPCB Chairman, the board has withdrawn the "consent to operate" the plant. The plant authorities have been directed to deposit Rs 5 crore within 15 days.

With the board withdrawing the "consent to operate", the plant authorities would not be able get fresh coal supply till the orders were stayed, sources said.

The plant management has been directed to comply with the observations of the team of PPCB officials that visited the plant on March 29, 2025. The next hearing in the case will be held in the second week of August.

## NORMS' VIOLATION

- The plant Chief Engineer claimed they were following most of the procedure and would file an appeal against the order

The PPCB order came following a complaint by Jagdeep Singh of nearby Thali village. He had alleged that fly ash from the plant was depositing on their houses, crops and elsewhere. The complaint was made in January 2024. During an inspection, the PPCB team noticed glaring violation of environmental laws by the plant authorities.

As per the copy of the orders available with The

Tribune, there is a high probability of leaching of ash slurry into the Sutlej due to the absence of pucca embankments and leachate collection or treatment systems around ash dykes. Fugitive emissions and poor road conditions near ash dykes pose significant health and environmental hazards. Ash-covered roads without water sprinklers or tire wash cause significant

secondary dust emissions due to vehicle movement.

The PPCB officials also found discrepancies in reported ash generation and utilisation data, indicating poor recordkeeping or intentional misreporting. Despite generating over 10 lakh metric tonne (LMT) of ash annually, the plant failed to meet the mandated progressive utilisation targets, particularly for bottom ash and legacy ash. The utilisation

of ash by the plant was just about 36 per cent.

The order also stated that no active chemical dosing was being done in the neutralisation tank for plant reject and the entire material was being discharged untreated into common drain connected to the Sutlej. No oil-water separator or hazardous waste containment was observed at locations where waste transformer oil and heavy fuel oil were found.

Plant Chief Engineer Harish Kumar Sharma said they would file an appeal against the order of the Punjab Pollution Control Board Chairman in the next few days. "We will move the appellate authority against the order. We are following most of procedure under the Act, but some of issues raised by the PPCB were practically not possible to comply with," he said.

# HC transfers Col Bath assault case to CBI Centre directs action after Mann seeks quick movement of rice

More than three months after the Punjab and Haryana High Court entrusted the investigation of the Colonel Pushpinder Singh Bath assault case to the Chandigarh Police, the Bench today transferred the probe to the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) on the Army officer's plea.

Col Bath was seeking an independent probe into the matter, preferably by the CBI, on the grounds that the Chandigarh Police "had failed to conduct a fair and free investigation".

Among other things, Justice Rajesh Bhardwaj's Bench was apparently of the

view that the Chandigarh Police had failed to conduct a fair and impartial investigation in the matter. UT Superintendent of Police Manjeet Sheoran, an AGMUT-cadre IPS officer heading the investigation, was present during the proceedings.

The observations and direction came just about two days after Justice Bhardwaj had admonished the Chandigarh Police for its failure to arrest any of the accused Punjab Police personnel. Describing the delay as intentional, Justice Bhardwaj had asserted that the conduct of the police amounted to "setting the wrong example" and protecting the accused.

At the onset, Col Bath's counsel Preetinder Singh Ahluwalia and Deepinder Virk blamed the authorities "for orchestrating the investigation to dismantle the case and betraying the court's trust". The Bench was told that the accused were serving officers of the Punjab Police.

The Bench was further told that the state had earlier argued that the custodial interrogation was necessary to ensure a fair probe and protect witnesses. It relied on Section 307 of the IPC regarding attempt to murder to oppose bail. But now they were withdrawing it without explanation.

After last year's procurement crisis due to storage constraints, the Centre has this time directed necessary action to enable the Punjab Government to create additional space for rice storage and aid procurement from farmers.

Food minister Pralhad Joshi gave the required orders after a review meeting with Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann here.

After the meeting, Joshi said the CM of Punjab met him at his residence and the discussions centred on farmers' welfare and food-grain procurement.

"Issues revolved around rice procurement from Punjab, optimal use of covered storage godowns, approval of private godowns under the Food Corporation of India. I have directed the

department to look at the issues and take necessary actions. The Central Government remains firmly committed to the welfare of Punjab's farmers and to ensuring a transparent, efficient and farmer-friendly procurement system," said the Union Minister.

Mann also sought the intervention of Joshi for the release of the state's pending share of over 79,000 crore related to the Rural Development Fund (RDF) and market fees. A state government release said that the CM also raised the issue of the non-allowance of the RDF since Kharif Marketing Season 2021-22 and insufficient allowance of market fees since Rabi Marketing Season 2022-23.

"The Chief Minister emphasised that the purpose of the RDF was to promote agriculture and rural infrastructure, including

the development of rural roads, marketing infrastructure, storage facilities in mandis and automation and mechanization of mandis. He said that despite amending the Punjab Rural Development Act, 1987, in accordance with the Department of Food & Public Distribution (DFPD) guidelines, the RDF had not been released since KMS 2021-22. CM Mann stated that Rs 7,737.27 crore under the RDF and Rs 1,836.62 crore under market fees were still pending from the Union Government," the statement said.

Mann noted that this non-reimbursement had severely impacted the development and maintenance of rural infrastructure and the rural economy. He said the Mandi Board and Rural Development Board were struggling to repay loans.
